

INTA Leads European Training on Quality Management System Reviews in Metrology

The Spanish National Institute for Aerospace Technology hosted EURAMET's course to strengthen competence and cooperation in European metrology



<u>19'dec.'25.</u>- The National Institute for Aerospace Technology (INTA) hosted a training course organized by EURAMET – The European Association of National Metrology Institutes, focused on the review of Quality Management Systems (QMS) in the field of metrology.

The event, held at the Metrology and Calibration Center from 29 September to 3 October, brought together 20 participants from 14 countries, including quality managers, peer reviewers, and technical experts. The training, partially funded by the Capacity Building Coordination Project (CaBuCo), aimed to strengthen competencies in evaluating quality systems in line with CIPM MRA requirements and EURAMET guidelines.

Over three days, attendees engaged in theoretical sessions and practical



## exercises on:

- QMS review procedures within the CIPM MRA framework
- Differences between peer review and accreditation
- · Best practices for reporting and technical visits

This initiative contributes to harmonizing quality management processes across Europe, improving the reliability of metrological services, and fostering international collaboration in scientific and industrial metrology.

This course reinforces INTA's position as a benchmark in quality and metrology, driving European cooperation and continuous improvement in management systems.
